Scholarships to Benefit Grand Blanc Students**

**Eldon L. Auker Scholarship Fund**

To be awarded to a graduate of Grand Blanc High School who has completed a college preparatory course of study, has a grade point average of 3.5 or better, demonstrated financial need, and accepted by any accredited college or university (not limited to the State of Michigan). The scholarships may be for more than one year, provided that the candidate remains in an accredited college or university and maintains a full course load (at least 12 credit hours each semester) during such scholarship year.

**Grand Blanc Rotary Scholarship Fund - Gregory Crane Award**

To award scholarships to graduates of Grand Blanc High School who are pursuing further education in college and/or a vocational school. The scholarship is awarded to a graduate of Grand Blanc High School with a grade point average of 3.0. Scholastic achievement is verified by Grand Blanc High School. Community involvement is listed on the application. Financial need determined by the Early Estimator Worksheet and a summary of need provided by the applicant. A Personal Statement is to be included with the application.

**Grand Blanc Rotary Scholarship Fund - Clarence Hill Award**

This scholarship is awarded to a graduate of Grand Blanc High School with a grade point average of 3.0, who has been accepted for college, and majoring in science or engineering. A Personal Statement is to be included with the application. Community involvement is listed on the application, and scholastic achievement is verified by Grand Blanc High School through a copy of the most recent transcript.

**Justin "Jubbs" Kosak Memorial Award**

To be awarded to a graduating student athlete senior of Grand Blanc Community Schools with at least a 3.0 GPA. Student athletes of all sports will be eligible to apply. Preference will be given to Football and Basketball players. Student will be viewed as being of good character and will have had no major discipline issues throughout their four years at Grand Blanc High School. Student will have a record of active community involvement and/or service learning. Student must submit an essay outlining their course of study, career goals and plans for financing their education. Consideration should be given to need as well as ability in determining a deserving recipient. Support will be provided for tuition, books, fees and/or college-related expenses for an accredited higher education institution or for a vocational/trade school.

A \$2,500 award will be provided. On-going funds of \$2,500 will be available to prior year award recipients for an additional three years. Additional year awards will be paid directly to the student's institution of higher learning pending they maintain full time status and a 3.0 GPA.
